SUPPORT PROGRAMS

Strategic Foundation Building (SFB) Retreats:

- Retreats engage participants in initial strategic planning for an arts in education partnership
- Partnerships receiving ESP funding must include cost of SFB retreat in grant application budget
- Schools or Cultural Organizations who have received LCB funding, or haven't been funded at all, may apply to TAP for funding for an SFB retreat (see below)

Technical Assistance Program (TAP)

- Administered by Partners for Arts Education (PAE) - www.arts4ed.org
- Awards range up to \$3,000
- These grants provide access to consultants for a wide range of needs, including program planning, evaluation and assessment, needs assessments, and travel to model sites and conferences. This grant can provide funds for ETSL training and support as well as SFB Retreats

GRANT PROGRAMS*

Local Capacity Building (LCB) grants

- Grants distributed by [26 sites](#) across the state
- Grants range up to \$3,000
- Minimum of three contact sessions
- School can partner with either an Artist or Cultural Organization

Empire State Partnerships (ESP) grants

- Grants distributed directly by NYSCA Arts in Education
- Funding goes to Cultural Organization partner
- Minimum of 10 contact sessions

■ **ESP Project-Based Support**

- **Planning** (up to \$8,000 – one year of funding)
- **Implementation** (up to \$15,000 – no limit on years)

■ **ESP School-Wide Arts Support**

- **Planning** (up to \$20,000 – one year, optional)
- **Implementation**
 - Five year sequential funding cycle
 - Up to \$25K, \$40K, \$60K, \$45K, \$35K (respectively, each year)
- **Dissemination** (no max amount or # of years)
 - Funding supports continued refinement of a successful ESP Implementation cycle, as well as dissemination into new partnership schools.

** All LCB and ESP grants are dollar-for-dollar matching grants*

SUPPORT NETWORKS

26 LCB Re-Granting Site Administrators

- Activities – such as orientations, one-on-one meetings, etc – depend on each regranting site and are specific to the LCB grant program
